- include training in the sowing of a range of herbicide, disease resistant and non-resistant crop and pasture species; and
- training in the application of soil incorporated herbicides pre sowing, followed by post emergent applications of label rate herbicides and fungicides at recommended application timings across all crop and pasture species.
